Pedal past iconic landmarks and hidden riverfront gems while uncovering the stories of the ancient port that connect Seville to the rest of the world.

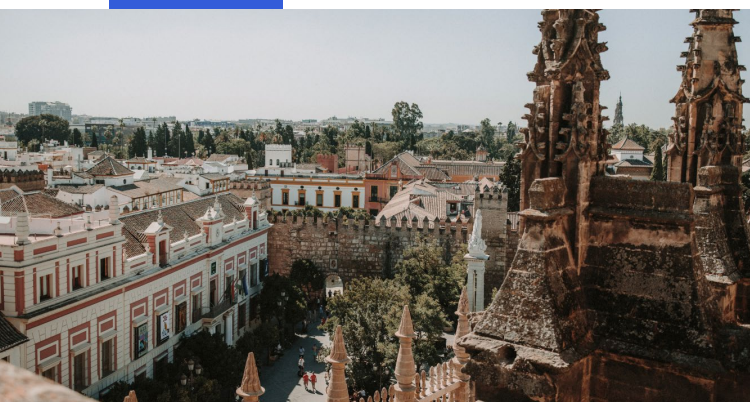
Week 9
